Meeting business:

- 1st Vice Chair Schillo's Report was about the phone list we used to reach out to Republicans and the reasons why people don't vote.
- 2nd Vice Chair Brigg's Report was about next month's Christmas party. We will have a pot luck dinner and we will be having a food drive to donate to our local Food Pantry.
- Mrs. Beavers discussed our Old Business having to do with establishing a Planning Committee for the 2026 elections, officially nominating Mr. McAvoy to the Board of Election and Registration, and the need for a Broad River Academy Scholarship Committee.

The Guest Speaker: Election Manager Tracy Dean covered her office's plan for County Polling Station consolidation. Twenty counties in Georgia have consolidated down to one including similar counties like Lumpkin and Stephens. She talked about Walton County going from 15 Polls down to 4 with 77,000 voters. She explained how consolidation will resolve issues like security, oversight, communications, power requirements and voter confusion.
